REQUIREMENT (ELIGIBILITY)

- Full time male and female undergraduate/graduate students in an accredited university or equivalent
- Students who have completed at least one semester at home university with CGPA of 2.5/4.0 (75/100) or above
- An official transcript must be ready at the stage of application.
- Graduate students must provide official transcript of graduate-level studies. (Undergraduate level GPA is not considered. Graduate level students must complete at least one semester of their graduate study at the stage of application.)

NOMINATION

Nominations are made through Ewha Womans University online system. It is a required process for exchange students; visiting (fee-paying) students do not need to be nominated from their home university. Detailed guidelines are sent to partner schools before the nomination period.

VISA

Students must obtain **D-2 student visa** **before their arrival**. Students with F-4 visa does not need D-2 visa. Students need to submit documents to a local Korean Embassy or consulate to apply for the visa. Certificate of Admission and Business Registration Certificate of Ewha will be sent by Ewha to students.

HEALTH INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

Students are required to sign up for two different types of insurance during their stay in Korea: the Korean National Health Insurance AND Private Insurance.

[1] Korean National Health Insurance (Mandatory)

All D-2 visa international students who plan to study in Korea will automatically be subscribed to the Korean National Health Insurance. This is mandatory for all students, regardless of whether they already have a similar insurance plan from their home country.

[2] Private Insurance: Ewha Group(Collective) Insurance OR Other Insurance (Must select one)

In addition to Korean National Health Insurance, students must carry an additional insurance policy. Students may obtain insurance through Ewha Womans University or arrange insurance coverage in their home country.

※ Cost of Ewha Group Insurance: 42,000 KRW per semester and 60,000 KRW per year
(Fees are subject to change.)

ON-CAMPUS HOUSING (DORMITORY)

Exchange/visiting students can apply for the on-campus housing when they fill out the application form (online). On-campus housing is not guaranteed, and rooms are assigned on a first-come first-serve basis. A negative tuberculosis (TB) test result issued on or after December 2026 will be required for students who have applied for and been assigned on-campus housing. Blood tests, skin tests, and X-rays are all acceptable.

Further instructions will be announced later once the housing assignments are available (expect it to be during late January). Therefore, please do not proceed with the TB test at this time and wait for further instructions.
